Project Location

Callen Run Road FOREST DISTRICT 08 Jefferson COUNTY, PA

Requirement

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Clear Creek State Forest required services to deliver, paver-place and roll approximately 2,710 tons of DSA (driving surface aggregate), to Callen Run Road.

Challenges

- Delivery had to be at a rate of 6 trucks per hour.
- No material were to be delivered before 7:00 a.m. or after 3:00 p.m.
- All trucks must be driven by individuals capable of placing material in a paver.
- Delivery had to be continued on an uninterrupted basis.
- All material must be certified to not degrade the environment nor create health hazards.
- Aggregate must originate from a PennDOT qualified quarry source. Quarry source must be approved for the production of C2A, as listed in PennDOT Bulletin 14.

Result

GDI completed the work successfully fulfilling all the requirements.
