#### Requirement



#### **Challenges**

- There was a concurrent government project for repaving highway 65, which effected hauling gravel for different roads.
- Scheduling had to be coordinated with other simultaneous works in Buffalo National River.

#### Result

 GDI completed grading, repair and spreading gravel successfully for all 4 roads in Buffalo National River.
